Rules of Engagement

- Tonight's contest will consist of ten trivia rounds.
- Listen carefully! The trivia host will read the questions and repeat them **only once**.
- Regular rounds will be four (4) minutes in length; Lightning rounds will be two (2) minutes in length.
- In the time allotted, teams must write down their answers on the answer sheets provided and submit to the scorers' table before time expires. The trivia host will provide a two-minute warning, a one-minute warning, a thirty-second warning, and a countdown of the last ten seconds. **No answer sheets will be accepted after time runs out in the round.** Once an answer sheet is submitted to the scorers' table, that is your final answer and your answer sheet may not be returned.
- Scoring:
 - Each correct answer = 10 points in regular rounds / 20 points in Lightning Rounds
 - A perfect score in a round = 100 bonus points
 - The maximum score for a round is 300 points
 - Highest score after 10 rounds wins.
 - In the event of a tie, highest scoring teams will participate in a sudden death playoff.
- Each team may purchase up to ten (10) EasyPasses at \$10 each. An EasyPass counts as one correct answer and can be used in any round unless instructed otherwise by the trivia host. There is no limit on how many may be used per round. Teams must select the specific question for which they are using the EasyPass by placing the EasyPass sticker over the specific question number on the answer sheet.
- There will be an intermission (halftime) between rounds 5 and 6.
- **Absolutely no "lifelines" outside of this room. The use of cellphones, other electronic devices or paper references during trivia rounds is strictly prohibited!**
- Play quietly. This is a competition. Others might be listening and not afraid to steal your answers shamelessly.
- All questions have been researched to the best of our ability. In all cases, you must assume that the answer the trivia host has is correct **regardless of whether you think it is wrong.**
- If any conflicts arise, the trivia host and scorers will serve as judges, and decisions will be final.
